## Instructions-

- Follow the steps to below to assemble the table runner.
- Read all instructions carefully before cutting.
- Use $1 / 4$ " seam allowance unless otherwise stated.
- Press seam allowance as shown by arrows.
- I recommend starching fabric before cutting. It will make cutting and sewing easier, especially when working with smaller pieces.

- WOF means width of fabric (based on $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide fabric).

Finished Table Runner Measures: $38^{\prime \prime} \times 15^{\prime \prime}$

*Yardage does not include needed materials for individual blocks.
**Yardage is rounded up to allow room for trimming.

## Zinnia Block Adjustment

To offset the flower block design, you will need to make a slight adjustment in one rectangle unit per block.

*Complete 2 units.

*Alternate placement of flowers as diagram and create 2 units.

The finished table runner measures $15^{\prime \prime} \times 38^{\prime \prime}$.

## FINISHING DETAILS:

Layer your backing fabric, batting and topper to create a quilt sandwich, quilt as desired. Piece the binding strips end to end and bind table runner using your favorite binding method.
